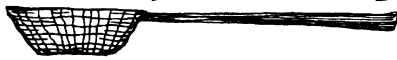

How did your spiritual life improve?

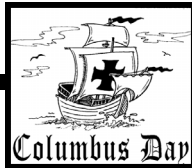
Did your relationship with Jesus deepen?
