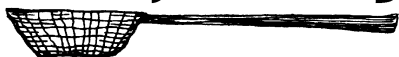

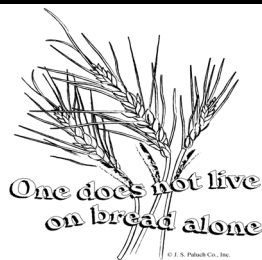

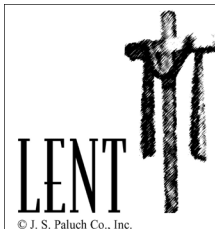

The Parish Mission will be presented by Rev. Adam A. Young on the evenings of March 23rd & 24th at 7:00 PM in Church.

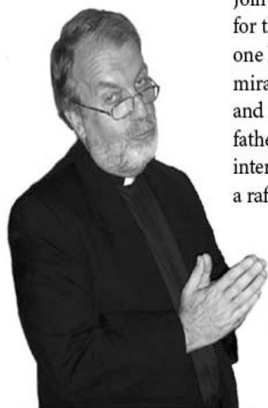

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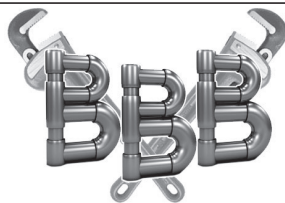
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
